The pregnancy diagnosis recorded on this certificate was based upon a single manual palpation of the uterus per rectum alone. The fact that the mare or filly was diagnosed as being pregnant on that date does not imply that she is carrying a viable single foetus. No liability shall attach to the examining veterinary surgeon if the mare or filly is later found to have aborted the pregnancy or is found to be carrying multiple foetuses.
